

Forthcoming activities of Board of Practical Training, Eastern Region.

Like previous years BOPT (ER), Kolkata is going to organize counseling session for 10+2 Vocational passed out students throughout 13 (thirteen) States in the Eastern Region under its jurisdiction in the month of January, 2009. All 10+2 Vocational passed out students aspiring to undergo one year apprenticeship training under the Apprentices (Amendment) Act, 1973 & 1986 in Life Insurance Corporation of India as 'Apprentices Career Agent' may contact the Head of the Institution from where they have passed Higher Secondary (Vocational) or they may seek information at the Divisional Offices of Life Insurance Corpn. of India. The detailed schedule of counseling/interview at various divisional offices of LIC will be available on this website from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2009.
2. The industry-institution meet at Aizwal, Mizoram is scheduled to be held on 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2008. Representatives from various establishments as well as institutions located in North Eastern States of India will be participating in the said meeting.
